

Technology Strategies for Scotopic Sensitivity

Advanced Software:

WYNN - Windows only, free trial version

- Adjust the background color in text view
- Adjust the text size and font using WYNN settings
- Adjust the spacing between words and between lines
- Adjust highlighting colors as the text is read aloud
- Masking: Similar to placing an overlay over the computer screen.
 - Masking is available when reading the web:
 - Able to mask by line, sentence, paragraph or full screen
 - Masking by line, sentence or paragraph is available when reading in text view.
 - You must select Read only from the Edit menu to use masking in text view.




Figure 1: Example of increased spacing between words and lines and color changes to text




Figure 2: Example of web masking in WYNN

Read and Write Gold - Available for Windows and Mac, free trial version

- Adjust highlighting colors as the text is read aloud
- Mask the screen in a variety of ways:
 - Full Screen Tinting tints the entire screen similar to using an overlay. Choose from a variety of colors and adjust the gradient
 - o Mouse underlining: The line that is being read is underlined with the student's chosen color for increased focus to that line.
 - Mouse spotlight options: Chose to read by line or by paragraph. Everything not being read at that time will be masked by the chosen color.




Figure 3: Example of mouse spotlight in Read & Write for Windows

Kurzweil 3000 - Available for Windows and Mac, free trial versions

Student is able to:

- Adjust the color background color (limited options with Mac version)
- Adjust the text size, text color, font, and word spacing
- Adjust highlighting colors as the text is read aloud




Figure 4: Example of a rose background color and highlighted colors as text is read aloud in Kurzweil 3000 for Windows

ClaroSoftware - available for Windows and Mac, free trial versions

ClaroView - Mac only

Student is able to:

• Use an overlay to change the color and tint of the screen.

ScreenRuler - Windows and Mac

- Use an overlay to change the color and tint of the screen.
- Use a reading ruler across the screen
- Use a colored underline that follows the cursor




Figure 5: Example of ClaroView overlay and control options

Rapid Reader - Windows only

- Read one word at a time with high color contrast setting
- Font and location of word can be customized to meet user's preference
- Speed of word displayed can be changed




Figure 6: Example of reading with Rapid Reader

Free Software for Windows:

SS Overlay

Student is able to:

- Use this program in place of a physical colored overlay on any computer.
 - o Downland SS Overlay: http://www.fx-software.co.uk/assistive.htm
 - Activate program by right clicking on the Yellow Up Arrow located on the toolbar on the bottom right-hand corner of the screen, and select Settings
 - Set your preferred color settings, select OK. This will activate the overlay.
 - To turn SS Overlay on and Off, Right click on Yellow Arrow located on the bottom toolbar. Select Exit.




Figure 7: Example of teal screen masking using SS overaly

T-Bar

- Use a colored bar to drag around the screen or lock to the mouse.
 - o Download T-Bar: http://www.fx-software.co.uk/assistive.htm
 - o To change the bar color and size, right click on the bar and select **Controls.**
 - To lock the bar to the mouse cursor, right click on the bar and select Lock.




Figure 8: Example of T-Bar

Windows Built Ins: Available in Windows 7, Vista and XP

Student is able to:

- Adjust the background color of the screen as it appears in Windows applications
- Adjust size, font and colors of toolbars in Windows applications within Display options
- These settings will carry over in Microsoft Word and Outlook

Windows XP

Changing the Background Color in Microsoft Applications

- 1. Right click on desktop
- 2. Select "Properties"
- 3. Select "Appearance"
- 4. Select "Advanced"
- 5. Click anywhere in Window Text Box
- Locate "Color 1": Use Drop Down Arrow to see recommended colors, "Select Other"
- 7. Choose your desired background color
- 8. Select "Add to Custom Colors"
- 9. Select "OK"
- 10. Continue to select "OK," Screen background will automatically change

Windows 7

- Step 1: Right click on Desktop
- Step 2: Select Personalize
- Step 3: Select Window Color
- Step 4: Select Advanced Appearance Settings
- Step 5: Click in White Space where it says "Window Text"
- Step 6: Select the drop down list under "Color 1"
- Step 7: Choose Other
- Step 8: Choose preferred background color by clicking on a color and adjusting the hue
- Step 9: Select OK > A sample of new background color appears in Active Window > Select OK
- Step 10: Select Apply
- Step 11: The screen should reset, open MS Word to see if the background color was applied

Free Software for Mac:

Screen Shades

Student is able to:

- Tint the entire screen with preferred color.
 - o <u>Download Screen Shades: http://download.cnet.com/Screen-Shades/3000-2094_4-</u> 209362.html
 - o Launch Screen Shades a Control Panel will appear.
 - o Select desired tint, or click on **My Tint** to customize the color.
 - o To adjust the tint darkness, move the scrollbar to the right or left.

iOS Built Ins - Mac and iOS Mobile Devices

Available in **Setting Preferences > Accessibility** on a Mac Available in **Settings > General >Accessibility** on iPad, iPhone, or iTouch

- Adjust contrast, invert colors, or use a gray scale
- Adjust size of font, and zoom options.
- In newer versions of MS Word for Mac, change the background color by clicking on **Layout** then **Color** under Page Background. Select preferred color.

Adobe Reader and Adobe Acrobat Pro

- Adjust background color in PDFs for Windows and Mac
 - Go to Preferences > Accessibility > click on Page Background
 - Use color pane to select preferred color
 - Note the PDF must be in an accessible format for this to work




Figure 13: Purple background color change in PDF

Voice Dream Reader - iOS only

Student is able to:

- <u>Download Voice Dream Reader: https://itunes.apple.com/us/app/voice-dream-reader/id496177674?mt=8</u>
- Adjust the background color, text size, and font
- Adjust the margins, line spacing, and character spacing
- Adjust highlighting colors as the text is read aloud
- Mask everything except for 1 line, 3 lines, or 5 lines

Screen Adjuster - Android only

- Download Screen Adjuster: https://play.google.com/store/apps/details?id=com.netmanslab.sa
- Tint the entire screen using an overlay
- Adjust the color, contrast, and brightness of the overlay
- Adjust system brightness
