Job Description

WEB APPLICATION DEVELOPER

The Massachusetts Developmental Disabilities Council is seeking a PHP developer to maintain and build enhancements to an enterprise project management system. This person must be a self-starter, be comfortable developing in a LAMP environment, and have excellent verbal and written communication skills.

The incumbent of this position is responsible for performing the following duties:

- Hands-on coding in PHP, CSS, HTML,
- JavaScript and server related scripting
- Documenting system processes, including code documentation.
- Monitoring the servers and application for usage, abuse, storage, memory, etc.
- Enhancement and development of features and functionality of the database
- Assigning and monitoring projects of other developers as directed by management.
- Communicating with management on issues, features and development progress.
- Conforming to the state digital applications guidelines.
- Keeping the Help system up-to-date.
- Maintaining backups accordingly.
- Participating in any audit of the system.
- Evaluating log files for usage and any security concerns.
- Directly communicating with users on features and/ or issues if needed. Communicate technically with 3rd party services/vendors.
- Candidate may be required at times to work outside the normal business hours, including weekends
- Perform related duties as assigned.

Required qualifications for this position include:

- 3+ years developing web applications under a LAMP stack environment.
- Working knowledge of SQL and Database administration, ideally MySQL or related SQL database.
- Working knowledge of Apache2 web server and configuration.
- Working knowledge of JavaScript and jQuery.
- Working knowledge of CSS, HTML5 coding.
- Familiarity with administering Linux servers, including maintaining cron jobs.
- Understanding of data-at-rest issues and implementation concerns.
- Working knowledge of SSL certificates - ordering, installing.
- Ability to manage/update DNS settings.

Additional preferred qualifications for this position include:

- Knowledge of accessibility standards and implementation - ARIA technology, screen readers.
- Knowledge of SEO requirements and implementation.
- Experience in Project development and specification writing skills.
- Experience in technical writing.
- Ability to prepare and conduct management presentations to management
