ELIGIBILITY

- All UW undergraduate researchers are eligible to present at Symposium.
- For Mary Gates Scholars, Washington Research Foundation Fellows, Levinson Scholars and recipients of Undergraduate Research Conference Travel Awards, presenting is <u>required</u>.

APPLYING

- If you're interested in applying, visit symposium.uw.edu/apply. <u>Applications close February 8</u>, 2024.
- The core requirement is a single abstract or artist statement. We have guidelines to support your writing! We allow students to submit one abstract or artist statement affiliated with a single project.
- Choose to present via poster, oral presentation, visual arts and design display, or by performance to best showcase your work. You can be assured that you will be able to present whichever way you choose in the application.
- Working on a group project? Work with co-presenters to submit. Note: Students cannot submit two applications themselves, but they can be added as a co-presenter on a second application.
- Work with your mentor before submitting to ensure your statement and application is as complete as possible.
